Running SPECTRUM 2.2 under Windows 7

Problem: Win7 does not support the full-screen mode that is required by SPECTRUM.

Workaround: Run SPECTRUM in a DOS emulator.

→ Download and install DOSBox for Windows from <u>www.dosbox.com</u> (I've tested version 0.73 for Win32).

Running SPECTRUM:

(Assume that the SPECTRUM files reside in the folder c:\spectrum)

- 1) Start the DOSBox by clicking on the corresponding desktop icon.
- 2) Assign a virtual drive to the SPECTRUM folder and to the folder containing your data. This is done by entering in the following commands in the DOSBox (press Return after each line):

```
mount s: c:\spectrum
mount d: c:\mydata
```

(Note that the letters for the virtual drives can be freely chosen; except for the letter Z, which is the pre-defined root level of the DOSBox)

3) Go to the spectrum\bin folder and start the program:

```
s: (through the virtual drive letter you get to c:\spectrum)
cd bin (change to the folder holding the program)
spectrum (run the program)
```

- 4) In the file selection menu press CTRL-D (or whatever letter you assigned in step 2) to go to your data directory.
- 5) When you are done, close the DOSBox using the command exit.

```
Notes: - SPECTRUM runs slow in the virtual environment.
- You may want to define an extra virtual drive for your output (e.g. mount o: c:\output)
